The purpose of the NNEI is to allow students at these schools to access a wider breadth of senior school curriculum choices with specialist teachers. Students remain attached to their home school campus and may attend a host school for a selected course. The NNEI has responded to community demands for excellence in education from their local schools.

The schools in the NNEI will deliver a range of courses and programs across the campuses. The shared courses will be offered in two-hour blocks, twice per week throughout the school year.

Trade Training Centre Programs will run on designated days.

NNEI - Travel between the schools.

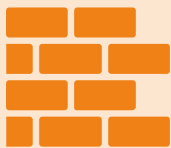
The Trade Training Centre courses are full day-release courses. Students are responsible for making their own way to the host school in the morning and home at the end of the day.

NNEI Provider School: Girrawheen Senior High School
(Delivered in partnership with North Metro TAFE - RTO 52786)

Students undertaking this qualification will complete a majority of their learning experience in a custom-built Trade Training Centre. They will have the opportunity to complete a Certificate II in Bricklaying, Plastering, and Tiling and attain units of competency in occupational health and safety, work planning, and basic use of tools and materials.

CPC20220 Certificate II in Construction Pathways - Building Maintenance: Bricklaying/Tiling/Plastering

NNEI Provider School: Girrawheen Senior High School
(Delivered in partnership with North Metro TAFE - RTO 52786)

This nationally recognised qualification provides students with hands-on experience and foundational skills in the construction industry. Designed in collaboration with industry professionals, the course prepares students for entry-level employment in trades such as bricklaying, plastering, and tiling, and introduces them to real-world workplace expectations.

Delivered at the Building and Construction Trade Training Centre, the program is run in partnership with North Metropolitan TAFE, allowing students to complete this Certificate while still at school.

- Industry-relevant skills and knowledge
- Practical training in bricklaying, plastering, and tiling
- Pathway into apprenticeships or further TAFE study
- Real-life learning in a purpose-built training facility
